This year, Chef Greg File of Silver Spoons Catering will offer three evenings of fine dining beginning with appetizers served in the 1813 Lewisburg Log House and Exhibit Hall. Start the evening with Greg's famous cheese puffs along with smoked Salmon, Whitefish Canapé's, stuffed snow peas with Boursin cheese, fresh fruit, warm mulled cider, and warm Bellagio sipping chocolate.

Candlelight, Bagpipes, traditional folk music, along with a bit of 1920's-1930's holiday Jazz music will entertain our guests throughout the evening.

You will dine in the warm glow of the historic Sayler-Swartzel House with the Bill of Fare as follows: Wild mushroom soup; Garni salad with Mandarin oranges, dried cherries and toasted pine nuts; sliced beef tenderloin with Bordelaise sauce and Horseradish cream; Marbella chicken with prunes, olives and capers in wine sauce; garlic mashed potatoes; mixed fresh vegetables in Olive oil, butter and fresh dill; dinner rolls, butter, homemade jams; Figgie pudding with Brandy Sabayon sauce; coffee, tea, and water.

The evenings of fine dining and holiday festivities are offered at only \$48 per person for society members, \$58 per person for non-members. A wine selection and after dinner liqueurs will be available at an extra fee.
